Featuring Kim Leadbeater, sister of Jo Cox MP

Jo Cox was a Labour MP murdered in 2016 for her political beliefs and her tireless action for justice and peace. Her sister, Kim Leadbeater from the *Jo Cox Foundation*, will speak about community cohesion and learning to live peacefully in diverse groups.

Other contributors include John Bond from *Initiatives of Change*, who will speak from his experience in peacemaking and reconciliation in Lebanon; and Stu Thomson from the *Oasis Hub Waterloo* who has worked on grassroots projects to reduce gang violence between young people in Brixton. There will also be workshops on nonviolent communication, disagreeing well, and creativity, plus worship and plenty of social time. All sessions optional.

It will also include FoR's AGM; members actively encouraged to participate! There will be a chance to see the new *Faith and Peace* exhibition, created by APF with the Peace Museum.

The event will have a focus on suggesting concrete actions to take for peace, and we hope that people will come away with hopefulness and ideas of what to do next.

The conference will start at 5pm on Friday (dinner included) and end after lunch on Sunday. We hope you can join us for the whole weekend. However, the theme and programme will still be coherent and complete if you're only able to come for Saturday.
